Congratulations on your admission to Rutgers University-Newark through the Educational Opportunity Fund (EOF) Program. The purpose of EOF is to increase access to higher education by providing academic support and financial assistance to qualified New Jersey residents.

To prepare you for the transition from high school to college, the Newark EOF Program offers the Academic Scholars Institute (ASI). ASI is a six-week commuter summer program that is required for all newly admitted EOF students. The ASI courses emphasize reading, critical thinking, mathematics, English, speech, laboratory science, and counseling. The development of study skills, academic discipline and time management at the college level are key components of the summer program. Please note that your admission to Rutgers-Newark is conditional upon your financial eligibility and successful completion of the Academic Scholars Institute.

### **Financial Aid**

Students admitted into the Educational Opportunity Fund (EOF) Program must be confirmed EOF eligible by the Office of Financial Aid at Rutgers University-Newark by May 15, 2014. If you are not confirmed EOF eligible by May 15th, your admission to Rutgers University-Newark may be rescinded.

#### Complete all items that apply:

#### Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) (Mandatory)

- A) If you have not filed a FAFSA, please go to the following website and complete the FAFSA immediately: http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/ Please confirm, you have selected the "2014-2015" FAFSA". The federal school code for Rutgers University is **002629.**
- B) If your parent(s) have completed the 2013 federal income tax forms, **LINK** your FAFSA to the **IRS**.

#### <u>Higher Education Student Assistance Authority (HESAA)</u> (Mandatory)

- A) Your state aid will not transfer to Rutgers if Rutgers is not listed as your <u>first choice</u>. For confirmation of first college choice, please go to **www.hesaa.org** and "Register", then "Login". Once logged in, click "Change my school choice or enrollment status" to make Rutgers your first choice.
- B) Additionally, click on "Report Additional Information for Student Aid" and complete the required information.

#### Federal Income Tax Forms (If Applicable)

Send a copy of your and your parent's **COMPLETE 2013** <u>Federal</u> Income Tax Forms (include <u>all</u> schedules and forms). Make sure that the Federal Income Tax Forms are <u>signed and dated</u>. Do NOT send <u>state</u> income tax forms.

#### Number in Household & College Worksheet (Mandatory)

Complete the 2014-2015 *Dependent* Verification Worksheet. This form must be submitted in conjunction with the required documents above.

If you are an independent student, you must submit the 2014-2015 *Independent* Number in Household & College Worksheet. Please note, you are an independent student if one of the following applies to you: (1) you are 24 years old; (2) you are married; (3) you have a child that receives more than half their support from you; (4) you are an orphan or ward of the court; or (5) you are a veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces.
